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Hunza Valley - 3hrs- Raikot Bridge - 2hrs-Dav Tato Village - 3hrs- Trekking to Fairy Meadows

Departing from Hunza, the day unfolds with a scenic drive along the renowned Karakoram Highway. Arriving at Raikot Bridge, transition to local jeeps for a thrilling ascent to Tato village. The journey continues with a picturesque trek through lush forests, revealing panoramic vistas. The day concludes as you reach the idyllic Fairy Meadows after 3 hours trekking, settling into your accommodation against the backdrop of the awe-inspiring Nanga Parbat. Night stay in Fairy Meadows

Fairy Meadows -1hr30mins- Beyal Camp -Dav 3hrs - Base Camp -4hrs - Fairy Meadows

Awakening to the breathtaking views of Nanga Parbat, the day unfolds with an exhilarating trek to the Nanga Parbat Base Camp. En route, marvel at the sheer grandeur of the world's ninth-highest mountain. Exploring Beyal camp and the base camp area, immerse yourself in the pristine landscapes. Returning to Fairy Meadows in the afternoon, there is ample time for relaxation, complemented by a delightful dinner and warm bonfire under the bright starline of Fairy Meadows. Night stay in Fairy Meadows. (Optional trekking to Nanga Parbat basecamp, those who do not want to experience physically challenging trekking, can just relax and explore the lush green meadows of Fairy Meadows)







The 11th day commences with a reflective morning in Fairy Meadows, capturing the last moments of its breathtaking beauty. After breakfast, embark on the trek back to Tato village, where local jeeps await to transport you to Raikot Bridge. As you journey back to Gilgit, the landscape unfolds once more, allowing you to savor the memories of your enchanting Fairy Meadows adventure. Arriving in Gilgit by afternoon, this brief but immersive tour leaves an indelible mark of natural wonder and tranquility. Night stay in Gilgit.

Gilgit -60mins- Islamabad Airport-30mins-Dav Lok Virsa -15mins- Faisal masjid



Catch a flight from Gilgit back to Islamabad. In Islamabad, explore the Lok Virsa Museum where you indulge yourself in the rich history of whole Pakistan, admire the iconic Faisal Mosque which is an architectural marvel and also the second biggest mosque in Pakistan. Visit vibrant Raja Bazar of Rawalpindi in afternoon and have a delicious dinner at top of Margalla Hills with birdeye view of whole Islamabad city. Night stay in Islamabad





Islamabad -3hrs- Khewra Salt Mines -50mins-Katas Raj -2hr30mins- Lahore

Embark on a journey from Islamabad to Lahore, exploring the cultural and historical gems en route. Begin with a visit to the mesmerizing Khewra Salt Mines, marveling at the intricate salt formations. Continue the journey to Katas Raj Temples, an ancient 500 years old Hindu complex surrounded by serene ponds. Conclude the day with a scenic drive to Lahore, savoring the rich history and diverse landscapes of Pakistan. Night stay in Lahore.

Hotel -30mins- Lahore Fort -1hr-Dav Wagha Border - 5hrs- Islamabad

Spend your day exploring the walled city of Lahore, the narrow historical streets and bazaars. Indulge yourself in Mughal History, visit Lahore Fort and Badshahi Mosque, which are architectural marvels made of red stone and Indulge in the local and famous street foods of Lahore throughout the day. Witness the world famous India-Pakistan Wagha Border Ceremony in the evening. Travel back to Islamabad and drop off at Airport or take flight back from Lahore.


