Day 1 Arrival at ✈ Islamabad, Pakistan

You'll be greeted at Islamabad Airport and transferred to your comfortable hotel. Enjoy your first night in Islamabad, Pakistan's vibrant capital. Night stay in Islamabad.



Day 2 Islamabad -9 hr 40mins- Chilas

Depart for Chilas, enjoying scenic views along the Karakoram Highway (KKH). Enroute visit Besham and Dasoo and multiple small towns each with a unique culture. Reach Chilas and relax after a day of travel. Overnight stay in Chilas.

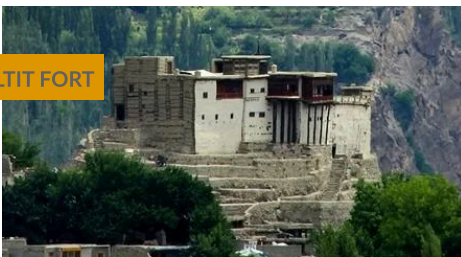


Day 3 Chilas -1 hr 56 min- Nanga Parbat View Point -2 hr 36 min- Karimabad bazar -2 hr 36 min- Attabad Lake

Continue the journey through breathtaking landscapes towards Hunza. Visit Nanga Parbat View Point and Rakaposhi View Point. Witness the amazing local culture of Hunza Valley and Karimabad bazar. Arrive at Attabad Lake, surrounded by turquoise waters. Overnight stay on the shores of Attabad Lake.

Day 4 Attabad Lake -30min- Passu -1 hr 50 min- Khunjerab

Explore the mesmerizing Attabad Lake, famed for its vivid turquoise waters. Witness the iconic Passu Cones, a photographer's delight, set against the backdrop of dramatic peaks along the majestic Karakorum Highway (KKH). Visit Hussaini Suspension Bridge in Passu. Also witness highest ATM in world and Khunjerab border (Highest border in World). Night stay at Attabad Lake.

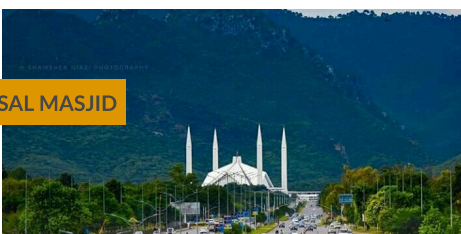


Day 5 Attabad Lake -60min- Baltit Fort -20min min- Altit Fort -20min min- Eagles Nest

Explore the majestic 1000 years old UNSECO world heritage sites of Baltit Fort and Altit Fort. Also witness the serene sunset having views of Ladyfinger peak and Diran peak at Eagle's Nest. Travel further to Gilgit in evening and overnight stay in Gilgit.

Day 6 Attabad Lake -10hrs- Besham

Head towards Besham, passing through captivating valleys along KKH. Reach Besham and relax after a day of exploration. Overnight stay in Besham. (Or travel to Naran passing Babuser Pass at 13,700 feet and witness the most scenic route towards Naran and overnight stay in Naran, only accessible from July-October)



Day 7 Besham -4hrs- Islamabad

Continue your journey back to Islamabad and spend your day exploring iconic Faisal Mosque and Lok Virsa Heritage museum, spend rest of the day in Islamabad and drop off at Airport at night after a delicious dinner.

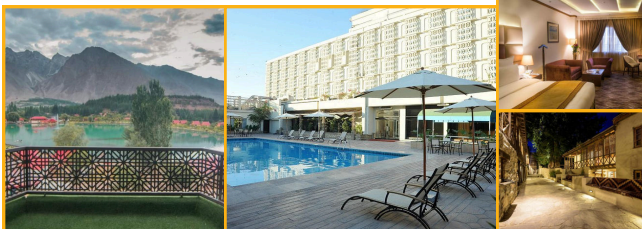
